

ST. BERNARD'S HEADPHONES

Hello St. Bernard's parents,

St. Bernard's will continue to require students to purchase headphones from the school. This plan has worked well for our students, since there are no issues with missing headphones, different types or styles of headphones, and all are of equal quality. These headphones can be used with the computer and iPads for any work that the students are doing in and out of the lab. Personal headphones are also more hygienic than the previous option of "community" headphones.

Here is where you parents come in! Headphones will need to be purchased for each student from the school office at the cost of \$15 per set. These headphones will belong to your student(s) and not be used by anyone else. They will be stored in a zip lock bag with each student's name on it, in a basket designated for each class. They will be available to students to use at school, but not allowed to go home. If your student moves away or graduates from St. Bernard's after 5th grade, the headphones will go with them or may be donated back for students that don't have them.

The headphones are of good quality and the students are excited about them. The \$15 will be added to all kindergartner / new student's tuition account. This will be a nice addition to the upgrades that we already have in place and will prove to be a valuable tool for the students going forward.

BACK TO SCHOOL NIGHT

Families will sign up for a slot on SignUp Genius to come to the school, acclimate to the classrooms, and bring supplies to leave in classrooms. During this time teachers will work with the students individually to gather a benchmark reading level.

DISINFECTING

Classrooms will have disinfecting sprays and wipes to use when children are not present- this will be on common touch spaces. School-wide disinfecting will occur at the end of each day.





EXTENDED DAY PROGRAM

Students will be separated through the entirety of Extended Day according to the school cohorts.



MASKS



Governor Walz's current mask mandate (which does apply to St. Bernard's) requires all occupants to wear a mask who are 5 years or older. PS / PK will not be required to wear masks, but Kindergarten - 5th grades will wear masks. Students will not be expected to wear masks when in physical activity, at lunch, or if outside and apart.





MASS

Mass will be staggered to three separate days allowing fewer students to celebrate the Eucharist at a single time. All mass times will be at 8:35 AM

OFFICE CLOSED

The school office will not be open during student drop-off or end of day dismissal. Parents will be able to enter the west / playground entrance to the school office outside of student arrival and dismissal if able to aff





PHYSICAL DISTANCING

St. Bernard's has capped each class to 16 students. Teachers are organizing their classrooms to encourage students to be physically separated. Our primary goal will be to assure students in cohorts, or groupings, do not overlap.

DAILY SCREENING

Individuals experiencing symptoms related to COVID-19 must refrain from entering the building: Fever | Chills | New Body Aches | Vomiting | Diarrhea | Loss of Taste or Smell | Dry Cough | Exhaustion

Health Screening will be at both the K-5 and PS / PK entrances. This will include a temperature check questions relating to above symptoms.





SPECIAL CLASSES

For classes such as physical education, music and technology, students may experience a different style of instruction to assure separation of materials, cohorts, and disinfecting.





WATER FOUNTAINS



Please note that each door will be <u>restricted</u> to different cohorts:


East / Church Door




