6. If squares are round, put a D in space 6, if not, put an F.

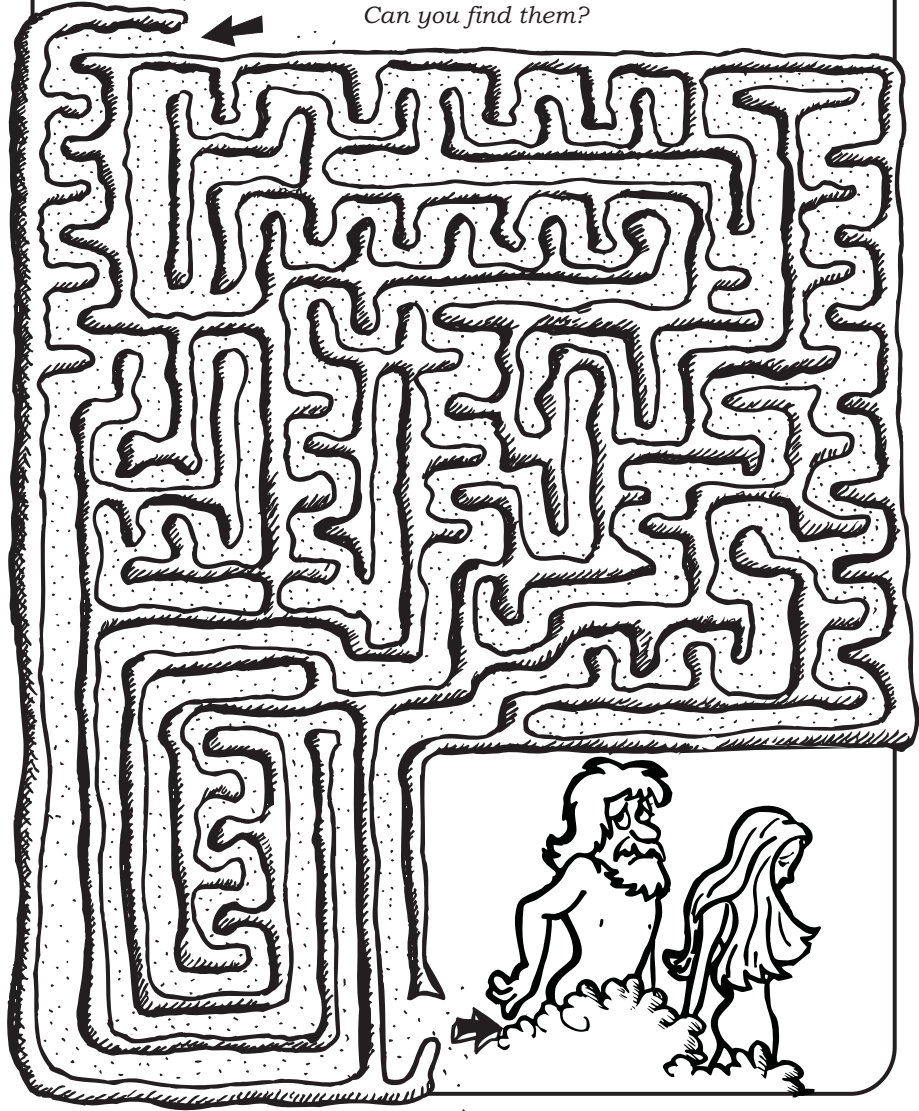

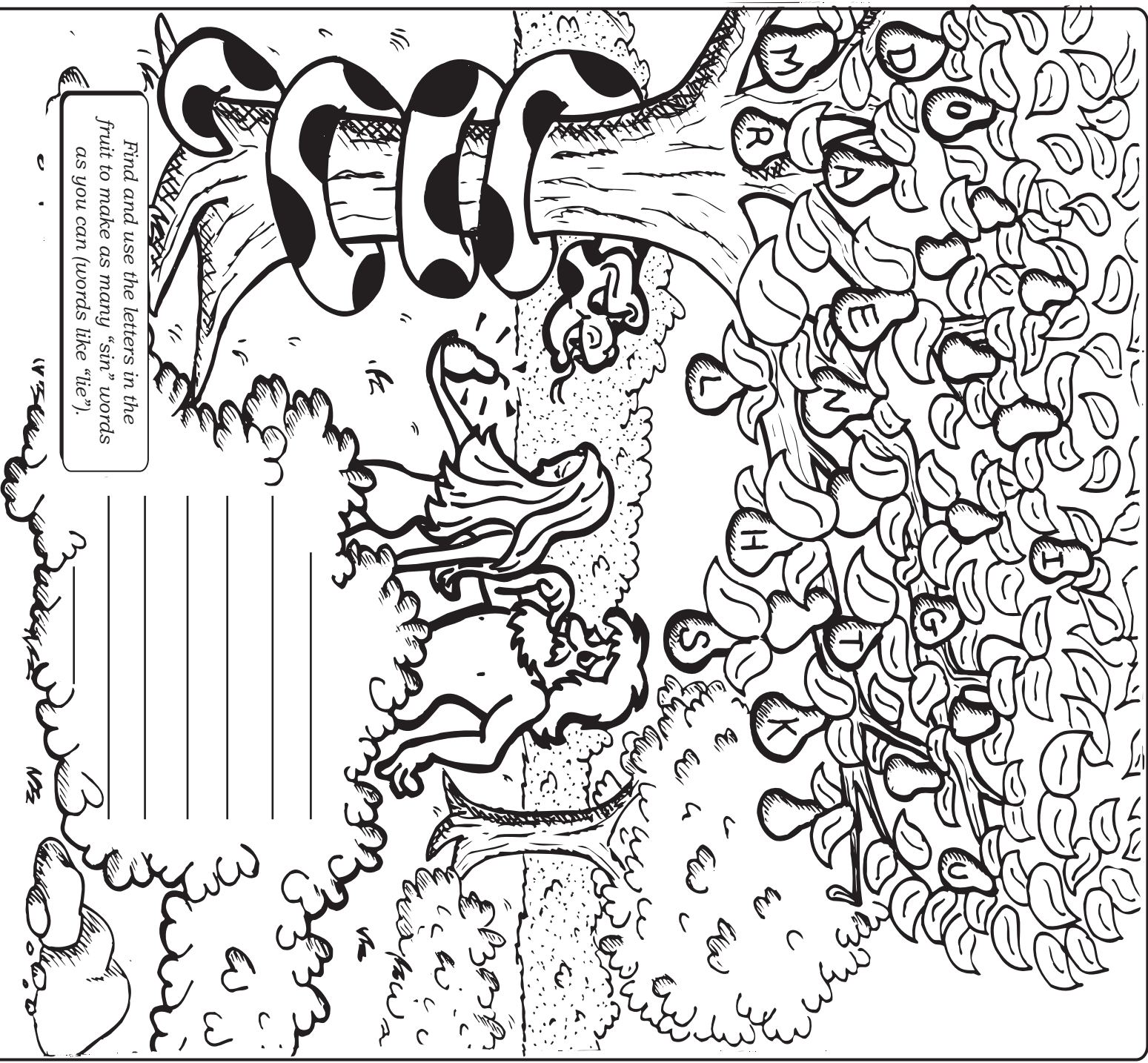
