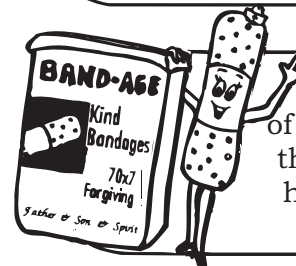

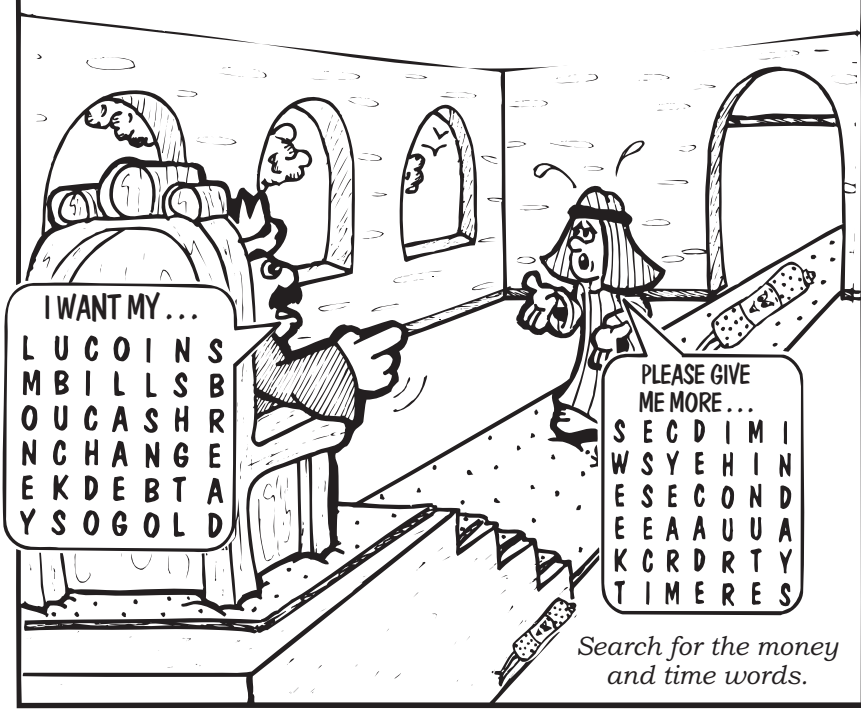
Color the dotted spaces in the tree.
