

LITURGICAL VESTMENTS

The Cincture

The cincture is a cord fastened around the waist, and it confines the alb, and as such are often worn both by clerics and servers. Cinctures are symbolic in two major ways. First it is a symbol of the cord that bound Christ to the pillar while he was being scourged (Luke 23:22). It also represents a guard against temptations of the flesh and purity of mind, body and heart, in other words, it is a symbol of self-mastery, one of the fruits of the Holy Spirit (Galatians 5:22).

While the priest is tying the cincture he prays: "Gird me, O Lord, with the cincture of purity, and extinguish in my loins the desires of lust, that the virtue of continence and chastity may ever abide within me."



Cincture



Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament is open to anyone who would like to pray in the presence of Jesus Christ in the Eucharist.


